

ESTA PG Certificate

for string teachers or piano teachers

2019

- ESTA PG Cert (string teaching) for teachers of bowed strings: violin, viola, 'cello and double bass, or piano teachers
- 2017: first intake started May. Bowed strings only
2018: second intake started May. Bowed strings only
- 2019: third intake starts August 2019 for **strings or piano**
- One year online course taught by the ESTA mentor panel
- Attend Summer School in UK: 11-16 August 2019
- Accredited at Level 7 i.e. Masters
- ESTA in collaboration with Chichester University UK

Learning online

- Logging on every day
- Watching and listening to webinars
- Engaging in follow-up work
- Meet with your mentor online through Skype as an individual and in your mentor group
- Benefit from access to Chichester university resources



The ESTA course: Masters level

- Worth 60 credits at UK level 7 - Masters
- 180 credits for a Masters



ESTA PG Cert (Bowed string teaching)

ESTA PG Cert (Piano teaching)

Invites teachers, new to the profession or well-established to:

- challenge their own assumptions
- become reflective practitioners
- attend the ESTA summer school
- work with Mentors drawn from an ESTA panel
- work with a Course Leader
