Semra's orchestral career began with the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra in 2000. She started in a tutti position with WASO in 2003 and was appointed Associate Principal Second Violin in 2004. In 2009, she won the Assistant Concertmaster job and has acted as Associate Concertmaster since 2014.

Semra has been guest concertmaster with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and has performed with the Australian World Orchestra.

She is co-artistic director of the Darlington Chamber Music series and founding member of the Darlington Ensemble which appeared in concerts for Musica Viva in 2021 and 2022.

A passionate advocate for new music, she has been involved in commissions from James Ledger, Emma Jayakumar and Simon Kruit, most recently recording Emma Jayakumar's *Bell Birds Suite* for the ABC. Semra's versatility as a performer has seen her record Troy Roberts' jazz/string quartet *Xenden Suite*, back Kate Miller-Heidke at One Day in Fremantle and feature as a soloist with WASO.
